Christian Friendliness is an interdenominational outreach seeking a passionate, committed person to reach out to primarily low-income kids and their families. This is an exciting opportunity to continue and expand an already established holistic outreach ministry.

Three Primary Functions:

1. Talk personally to each individual camper in your group and give each the opportunity to make a spiritual decision.
2. Be sensitive to the physical and spiritual needs of your campers.
3. Serve together with C.I.T. and be an example of leadership to them.

Position Requirements:

- Called into full-time, inner city ministry by God.
- High School Graduate/College Student
- Passionate about working with children and youth.
- Energetic and creative.
- Ability to manage and oversee groups of campers.
- Participate in raising support for the ministry.
- Setting the pace for the campers.

Position Duties:

- Be a part of your group without being one of them. Campers look to the counselor for friendship, but also for authority.
- Put the well being of the campers before your own personal desires.
- Perform additional tasks and duties assigned by the camp and program directors.
- As part of your spiritual ministry to your campers:
 - Lead devotion.
 - Lead campfire sharing times on camp outs.
 - Be responsible for the conduct of your campers.

Position Compensation:

- Option 1
Receive a stipend of \$500 from Christian Friendliness. Receive up to another \$3000 from personal fund-raising done through and with guidance from Christian Friendliness. Any additional money received after \$3,500 will be given to CF as a donation.
- Option 2
Receive a weekly salary of \$210 per week for the 9 1/2 weeks of summer. Personal fund-raising is still required.
- Food/Lodging during the week and arranged housing on weekend
- Celebration dinner every Friday
